ANNOUNCEMENT

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

Hope Cup 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations for Figure Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for Figure Skating and the classification of the Estonian Skating Union for season 2021/2022.

Participation in the Hope Cup 2022 is open to all competitors and clubs who belong to an ISU Member. All invited clubs, ISU-Members or Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class.

However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

All C-class categories will be calculated according to "Friendship tournament Hope Cup 2022" classification for C-class", using ISU judging system.

The competitions follow the principles established by the Estonian Government for preventing the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

As of pandemic situation caused by COVID-19 all participating Teams, Officials and related personnel are responsible of checking active restrictions and guidelines introduced by Estonian Government, Estonian Health Board and the Organizing Committee of the event.

AWARDING:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a medal. All competitors will receive a diploma.

JUDGES:

Each participating Club may nominate one, at least international level judge. The organizer will cover the accommodation and meals. Transportation will be not covered by the organizer.

EXPENCES:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

MUSIC:

Music must be recorded on CDs and submitted at the time of accreditation. The music medias must be of good quality and labeled clearly with the Competitor's name, Nation, category and the exact music time. Each program must be recorded on a separate disc.

PROTOCOL:

The protocol will be available on the organizer's website: www.iktartu.ee

ACCOMMODATION:

The Organizers shall not arrange accommodation.

PROTESTS:

Protests must be submitted not later than 48 hours after subsegment. Protest can be made against the right determination of the executed element or any calculation error. In case of wrong determination of the executed element, all technical panel members (technical controller, both technical specialists, data operator) have to agree with correction of error. The recording by the organizers will be taken into account. The protest fee is 50 EUR. Protest must be done in a written form to the referee of the relevant segment. If the referee is not available, the protest must be submitted to the secretariat.

Please read ISU Rule 123.

RESPONSABILITY:

In accordance to ISU Constitution, rule 119, all participants act at their own responsibility.

THE CODE OF ETHICS:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 1433. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.
