INTERCLUB FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION FOR SINGLE SKTERS

Technical data

C-CLASS

PRE-CHICKS C Girls and Boys (born 2015 and younger)

Free Program: 2:00 min \pm 10 sec

1. Maximum of four (4) and minimum of two (2) jump elements

- maximum of two (2) jump combinations. Jump combinations may consist of only two (2) jumps. **A jump sequence is not allowed.**

- 1A, 1F, 1Lz and double (2) jumps are not allowed

- **Waltz jump is allowed in Pre-Chicks C category and has a value 0.20**

2. Maximum of two (2) spins, each spin in one position (**spin in only one (1) position will be counted**, minimum of 3 revolutions each)

3. One step sequence (2/3 ice covered)

Please note that Pre-Chicks C category is for very beginner level skaters!

Components that are judged:

- skating skills

- performance / execution

The factor for the Program Components is 1.5

The level of spins and step sequences cannot be higher than Base . Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

CHICKS C Girls and Boys (born 2013/2014)

Free Program: 2:00 min \pm 10 sec

1. Maximum of four (4) jump elements - maximum of two (2) jump combinations.

Jump combinations may consist of only two (2) jumps. **A jump sequence is not allowed.**

- 1A, 1F, 1Lz and double (2) jumps are not allowed
 - Waltz jump is allowed in Chicks C category and has a value 0.20
2. Maximum of two (2) spins, each spin in one position (spin in only one (1) position will be counted, minimum of 3 revolutions each);
 3. One step sequence (2/3 ice covered)

Please note that Chicks C category is for very beginner level skaters!

Components that are judged:

- skating skills
- performance / execution

The factor for the Program Components is 1.5

The level of spins and step sequences cannot be higher than Base . Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

NB! Additional information

1. Evaluation is in accordance with ISU Comm. 2334 and additions related to this document.
2. Any jump element may be executed only twice (2).
3. Time violation - 0.5 point deduction for every 5 seconds in excess. 4. Falls -0.25 point deduction for Pre-Chicks C, Chicks C
5. In the free program there will NOT be a higher coefficient for jumps on the second half of the program.
6. Protests must be submitted not later than 24 hours after subsegment. Protest can be made against the right determination of the executed element or any calculation error. In case of wrong determination of the executed element, all technical panel members (technical controller, both technical specialists, data operator) has to agree with correction of error. The recording by the organizers will be taken in to account. The protest fee is 50 EUR. Protest must be done in a written form to the referee of the relevant segment. If the referee is not available, the protest must be submitted to the secretariat.

Please read ISU Rule 123.

7. Skaters are allowed to participate in a higher category if their skills meet the technical requirements of that category.

8. There may be up to 10 skaters in one warm-up group. Warm-up time: 4 minutes
